 - a. Negatively, we must totally repudiate everything we know to be wrong, and not even “think about how to gratify the desires of the sinful nature.”*

 - b. Positively, we are to set our minds on the things the Spirit desires, set our hearts on things above, and occupy our thoughts with what is noble, right, pure and lovely.*

- 3. Why should we practice mortification?**
 - a. We have an obligation to the indwelling Spirit of life.*

 - b. Mortification is the only road to life.*
